## Occupational Therapist – Forensic Environment Part-time or Full-time (2 days/week to full time)

## **POSITION OVERVIEW:**

Reporting to the Owner/Manager of Block Building Therapies, the Occupational Therapist will operate with a high degree of independence as a member of a forensic multidisciplinary team engaged in rehabilitation of Youth Offenders in the Manitoba Justice system. The incumbent will participate in the planning, delivery and evaluation of required needs within the scope of occupational therapy services; using a client centered, goal orientated approach for this demographic. These services include assessment, direct intervention, consultation and public/parent/caregiver education and training within a variety of settings, both in facilities and community settings within Winnipeg and the province of Manitoba. The Occupational Therapist may also provide clinic supervision and training to provisional members and participate in the education of other community members as required. The incumbent will exercise the appropriate level of initiative and independent judgment in determining work priorities, work methods to be employed and action to be taken on unusual matters.

- Master's degree or equivalent entry level requirement in Occupational Therapy.
- Active registration with the College of Occupational Therapists of Manitoba (COTM).
- Eligible for membership with the Canadian Association of Occupational Therapists.

- Demonstrated effective decision making, and problem-solving skills.
