# Community based Rehabilitation Support Worker (RSW)

Will provide Occupational Therapy, Physiotherapy and Speech Language Therapy rehab under the direction of a clinician. The RSW will provide regular feedback and complete appropriate documentation for Client sessions, be involved in interdisciplinary team conferences and work with a high level of independence. The RSW may be required to pick up and transport clients in their own personal vehicle. Rural travel may be required.
